## PGC Members

Our members come from all walks of life and represent a talented group of pilots. The age range of glider pilots is the greatest in aviation, from our youth scholarship members starting at 13-years old to some of our most experienced pilots who are World War II veterans. Our Certified Flight Instructors are highly qualified and safety oriented. From your first flight to advanced training you will fly gliders in a supportive club atmosphere.

## Cost of Flying at PGC

Flying gliders is an affordable form of aviation, particularly when compared to powered flight. For PGC members *flight instruction and use of the gliders is free, you pay only the cost of a tow for each flight.*

Membership cost includes annual dues, a refundable bond, and a one-time initiation fee. After the first year members pay only annual dues and tow fees.

## The Aircraft Fleet

PGC features one of the best club fleets in the country. We fly comfortable modern sailplanes that prepare students for advanced training and provide rated pilots with very capable soaring machines. The fleet consists of:

- 1 - Grob G-102 Single-seaters
- 1 - Schempp-Hirth Duo Discus
- 1 - Discus - Single-seater
- 1 - Piper Pawnee Tow-plane
- 1 - Cessna L-19 Tow-plane
- 1 - Twin-drum Eagle Winch

## Learning to Fly

PGC is known for our comprehensive flight training program. Our FAA Certified Flight Instructors will guide you through the training syllabus from your first flight in a glider to earning your pilot's certificate. The club environment provides a tremendous amount of aviation knowledge to be absorbed, augmenting the formal training program. The pace of your learning experience is individualized and depends on how often you fly.



## Transition Pilots

For those already holding a power pilot's certificate, soaring adds a new dimension to your aviation experience. Many PGC members have ratings ranging from Private Pilot ASEL through a Commercial Airline ATP. The transition to gliders for power pilots is individualized to meet your training requirements.
